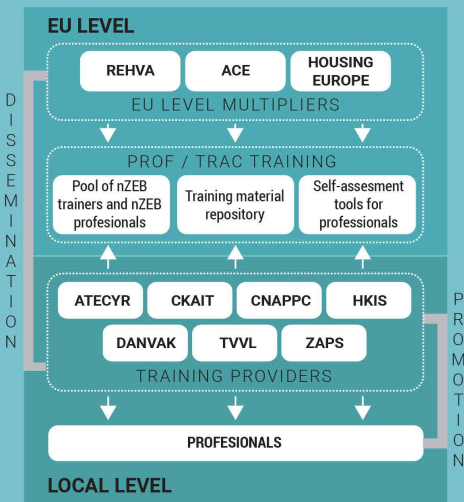


PROF / TRAC TRAINING AND QUALIFICATION SCHEME

Pilot courses and the roll-out of the training scheme

Seven pilot courses will be held in the second year of the project in Denmark, The Netherlands, Spain, Italy, Czech Republic, Slovenia and Croatia, starting in June 2016. PROF/TRAC aims at training 700 professionals during the project, and 1500 in total by 2020 within the sustained scheme enrolling new training providers.

Members of the EU level federations- REHVA, ACE and Housing Europe will be opened for other involved training providers across Europe once developed.

Professional multi-disciplinary training and continuing development in skills for nZEB principles

PROF / TRAC is a three year-long EU funded project which started in March 2015. 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PROF / TRAC OBJECTIVES AND FIRST OUTCOMES

Mapping of Skills and Qualifications

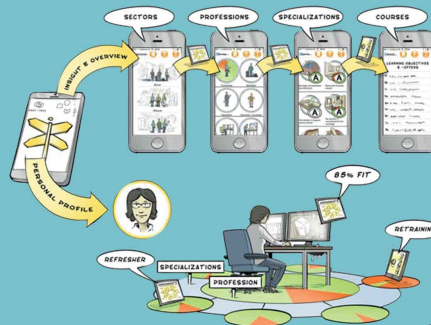
PROF/TRAC developed a common methodology for the mapping of skills and qualifications, based on the BUILD UP Skills experiences. Professional profiles and skill gaps are mapped. The seven partner countries have already mapped out the skills and qualifications to identify the market trends and training need in Europe. The skills mapping methodology will be offered to the training providers that join the scheme.



The European Training and Qualification Platform

The PROF/TRAC online open training platform serves as:

- Information pool about the European training programme, trainers and training organisations, and professional profiles needed for nZEB (construction and renovation).
- A repository of existing training materials related to nZEB (construction and renovation)
- A European Mutual Learning Platform for building professionals with online training tools and the PROF/TRAC App.



Train the Trainers Programme

PROF/TRAC developed a European Train-the-Trainers (TtT) Program to facilitate the efficient use, adaptation and implementation of the EU level training materials, existing training structures, and certification schemes into national CPD programmes. The 'trained trainers' will act as ambassadors for the developed nZEB qualification scheme and will take care of a further roll-out and implementation of the action on national scale, customized to national needs and context. The 1st(TtT)session was organised in Prague, February 2016, training 20+ professionals from the 7 countries.
